imagineCALGARY Awards 2010 Nomination Package

The imagineCALGARY Awards have been established to recognize and celebrate achievements and actions that help achieve the Vision of *The imagineCALGARY Plan*. Each year, outstanding contributions towards the long-term sustainability of Calgary will be recognized through two awards – the *Partner in Action Award* and the *Leadership in Sustainability Award*.

NOMINATION INFORMATION

Organizations nominated for an imagineCALGARY Award must meet the following criteria:

- Nominees must have conducted operations in the Calgary trade market, within a 10-kilometer radius of established city limits, for a minimum of three years prior to the date of nomination.
- Nominees must be Calgary-based or be a local branch of a provincial, national or international organization.
- Crown corporations and Cooperative Associations are eligible to be recommended for nomination.
- Nominees must demonstrate sound financial standing evidenced through the provision of an annual financial statement and where possible an Annual Report.
- Nominees must operate within ethical and transparent reporting guidelines.

HOW TO SUBMIT A NOMINATION

Step 1:

Review the award categories and determine which category is most appropriate for the organization you wish to nominate. The two awards do not share all eligibility requirements.

Step 2:

Complete the appropriate nomination form for the award (included in this document).

Step 3:

Mail, fax, email or hand-deliver your nomination packaged to be received by **Friday, September 24, 2010 at 4:00pm (MDT)**. Nominations received after this date will not be considered.
